EDUCATORS - HOME VISITS / MONITORING

POLICY

The Co-ordination Unit monitors Family Day Care Educators through regular Home or In-Venue Visits to ensure a high standard of quality care is provided.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Home and In-Venue visits and monitoring may include:
 - an initial Safety Check for potential Educators
 - an annual Home Safety Check
 - Educator resource & support visits
- 2. Educator visits must relate to the position description and guidelines for Educators.
- 3. A record and written documentation of monitoring visits should be completed at the visit, discussed and signed by the Field Worker and Educator. These records are filed on Educator's file.
- 4. Educator should be encouraged to discuss ideas and information about the Family Day Care Scheme and children in their care.
