FACILITIES - LAUNDRY

POLICY

To maintain the health and well-being of children and to minimise the risk of cross infection, FDC homes must have adequate and hygienic arrangements for laundry requirements.

PROCEDURE

- 1. The Family Day Care home must have laundry arrangements either on the premises or through another facility, service or arrangement.
- 2. The Family Day Care home must provide safe and sanitary facilities for the storage of soiled clothes, linen and nappies pending their laundering or disposal.
- 3. All chemicals and dangerous substances must be stored out of reach of children.
