## HEALTH & SAFETY - DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES/ITEMS

## POLICY

There are many household substance that may pose a threat to young children, either through injury or poisoning. Many of these are contained in bright attractive packages, or resemble things a child may perceive as a toy, such as a gun or cigarette lighter. It is therefore important that Educators are vigilant in ensuring these items are always stored in a safe place out of access to children.

## PROCEDURE

- 1. The telephone number for the Poisons Information service must be kept near the phone/s.
- 2. All poisons and toxic material must be stored in original containers and kept out of reach of children.
- 3. All flammable liquids are to be stored in containers correctly labelled and designed for the storage of flammable liquids, and kept out of reach of children.
- 4. All insecticides are to be limited in their use and used only according to manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Matches, lighters and explosive substances are to be kept out of reach of children.
- 6. All sharp pointed and jagged objects, including kitchen utensils, are to be made inaccessible to children.
- 7. All firearms must be licensed and stored, unloaded, in a locked cupboard separately from ammunition, in accordance with the Firearms Act.
